

# BMWCCV MOTORSPORT SCRUTINEERING.



## 1. BEFORE THE EVENT .

- **Please use and familiarize** yourself with this sample checklist.
- **Allow yourself plenty of time** before the event date to have your car ready. (for advice contact the Chief Scrutineer, don't leave it until the day before the event).
- **If this is your first event,** plan to arrive at the track at least 1 hour before Scrutineering begins. (Note: \*some items can be purchased from the Club on the day, limited stocks only, check if what you need will be available.)

## 2.ON ARRIVAL AT THE TRACK :

- Check in and/or register with the Event Secretary.
- You will be given a blank copy of the following list.
- If this is your first event, please introduce yourself to a fellow first time entrant and do your prechecks together.
- If you are unsure of an item enquire with Chief Scrutineer that the item is ready for scrutiny before joining the line up.
- You must complete all info details and pre check list before your vehicle is eligible for scrutiny.

## 3. SCRUTINEERING

Please do not line up for Scrutineering before you have:

- Provided all details requested on the form and carried out the pre-check.
- Taken adequate time to check.

Be aware:

- There are often many vehicles to be scrutineered and mistakes/non compliance causes unnecessary delays.
- If you cause unnecessary delays by ignoring the above, you could delay the programme and/or miss your first session.

When ready:

- Join the line up with the checklist ready and stay in the car until you are requested to stand aside.
- Remain beside your vehicle and be ready to assist the Scrutineer.
